**About the Show:** The most beloved musical of all time, Lerner & Loewe's My Fair Lady returns to Broadway in a lavish new production from Lincoln Center Theater. Directed by Tony winner Bartlett Sher, the stellar cast tells the story of Eliza Doolittle, a young Cockney flower seller, and Henry Higgins, a linguistics professor who is determined to transform her into his idea of a "proper lady." The classic score features "I Could Have Danced All Night," "The Rain in Spain" and "Wouldn't It Be Lovely." The original 1956 production won six Tony Awards and was hailed as "one of the best musicals of the century."

**About the Trip:** The bus will depart the Municipal Complex, located at 1 Collyer Lane, Basking Ridge. You will receive your tickets on the bus. The bus will drop off at the Lincoln Center Theater-Vivian Beaumont, located at 150 West 65th St., at approximately 11:30 AM. Lunch is on your own. Show time is 2:00 PM. Show is approximately 3 hours, with intermission. Bus will depart NYC immediately following the show.

**About the Tickets:** Tickets are \$125 per person – includes SIDE LOGE seating (see chart on page 2 for details) and motor coach transportation. Non-refundable once paid. Recommended for ages 8+. Children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult.

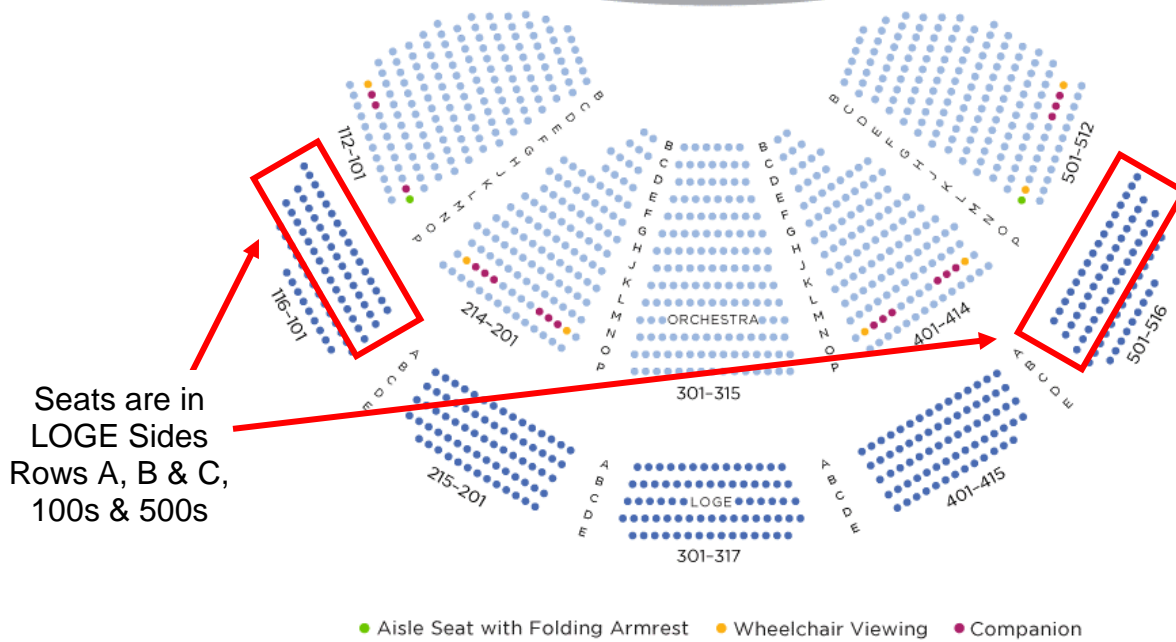

### Details on the Theatre's Accessibility

Wheelchair access to the Lincoln Center Theater box office, serving the Vivian Beaumont, Mitzi E. Newhouse and Claire Tow Theaters, is available from the street-level entrance on 65th Street. Enter through the glass doors in front of the large curved mural, and use the wheelchair lift on the left. The doorbell next to the lift will call a security guard to assist if necessary. The Beaumont lobby and orchestra level is accessible by a ramp located to the right of the box office.

Wheelchair access to the Beaumont and Newhouse Theaters is available from the street-level entrance via a manned elevator located to the right of the large mural.

#### **Vivian Beaumont Mezzanine:**

Called Loge at this theater. Due to structural limitations, this location is not accessible. Located up 2 flights of stairs, 30 steps. Entrance is behind Row E and there are approximately 1-2 steps down per row to reach all other Loge seats.

#### **Closed Captioning**

Handheld closed captioning devices are available in the Vivian Beaumont Theater three weeks after a show's opening performance.

#### **Restroom**

Wheelchair accessible restrooms are located on the lobby levels of the Vivian Beaumont, Mitzi E. Newhouse and Claire Tow Theaters.
