Entrance and parking located on Allen Road

Farmstead Park & the Passaic River

Entrance and parking located on King George Road

Mountain Park Walking Trails

Entrance and parking located off Martinsville Road and Mountain Road



Due to limited parking at certain locations, residents are encouraged to walk or bike where able.

Bus Tour

A bus tour will also be available at 1PM and 2PM, departing from Town Hall at 1 Collyer Lane, Basking Ridge which will highlight properties such as Schmidt Park, the Dead River Trail, and McCollum Farm.
