Following roads remain closed:

Whitenack Rd & Emily Rd – Tree and wires down
Manchester Dr & Tangelwood Ln – Tree and wires down
Harrison Brook Dr – Tree down on wires
Pennington St – Tree down (unknown wires)
Dryden Rd – Wires down
Douglas Rd near Mine Brook – Tree and wires down
Old Army Rd near Old Farm Rd – Wires down
Long Rd – Trees and wires down in Bridgewater
Peachtree Rd cul-de-sac – Wires down

Following roads remain obstructed or otherwise compromised:

Flintlock – Tree blocking lane – no wires
Deer Creek Dr – Tree blocking lane – no wires
Spencer Rd near Lake Rd – Tree on wires, obstructing road but passable for cars
Old Farm Rd near # 122 – Primary wires on ground but roadway open
Washington Ave & Conkling – Primary wires on ground but roadway open
Lyons Road by Lyons Place – Tree blocking lane – no wires
Gerard Ave and Debra Ln - Tree blocking lane – no wires
