

BERNARDS TOWNSHIP STORM UPDATE

Pill Hill Revised Hours of Operation

Due to heavy tree damage experienced during these recent storm events, we are expanding our Pill Hill hours of operation to include Sunday, March 18 and Sunday, March 25 from 12:00 noon to 4:00pm. The month of April will follow our springtime schedule which includes Sundays from 12:00 noon to 4:00 pm, except for Easter Sunday .

We ask that any tree 8 inches or larger in diameter be cut into lengths not to exceed 6 feet. Also, absolutely NO ROOTS OR STUMPS shall be accepted.

For residents hiring commercial contractors utilizing Pill Hill, you must accompany your contractor and provide the gate attendant your Pill Hill card and appropriate Identification. Please be sure to relay the lengths of wood accepted to your contractor.

Finally, in keeping with past policy the Department of Public Works will be cleaning up fallen branches that fell from right of way trees onto Township roads and/or sidewalks. Residents are responsible for right of way trees that dropped limbs onto their property. Please do not place any tree debris to the curb .
