MAIN INSTALLATION PROJECT TO START SOON

New Jersey American Water is preparing to install approximately 2,800 feet of new 20-inch transmission main along **North and South Maple Avenue** (from Prospect Avenue to East Craig Street) and another 1,860 feet of pipe will be installed within an easement leading to the company's booster station. The project represents a critical investment for the company in support of our commitment to provide customers with safe, reliable water service.

PROJECT START/END AND WORK HOURS

Weather permitting, our contractor, CRJ Contracting, will begin work along Prospect Avenue first, which will begin on or about June 10 and take approximately four weeks to complete. Work hours along Maple Avenue will be from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday through Friday. Phase 2 involves the pipeline installation work within the easement. This work will begin as soon as weather and operational requirements allow, and be performed during day time hours from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Phase 2 will take approximately three weeks to complete. Work outside of these hours along Maple and the easement are not expected unless required to maintain project schedule. Final street restorations will be completed this fall.

PROJECT OVERVIEW AND WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT

- **Install, disinfect, test and place new main into service.** While we interconnect the new main to distribution system, customers may experience a temporary service interruption. Customers may also experience a slight discoloration of water. If this happens, run the water until it is clear.
- **Perform final paving and any restoration of concrete, driveway, grass and landscaping.**

Our crews will work as quickly as possible to shorten the length of these temporary inconveniences. We appreciate your patience and understanding during this project.

TRAFFIC FLOW AND ACCESSIBILITY

For the public's and workers' safety, traffic will be detoured during work hours. New Jersey American Water's inspector, along with the contractor's personnel, will provide a minimum of 24 hour's notice prior to any parking and/or driveway use restrictions. All residents and emergency vehicles will be allowed access during construction.

NOISE

As with any construction project, some noise will be unavoidable with this project. We apologize for any inconvenience, and appreciate your understanding and cooperation.

SITE MAINTENANCE

The project site will be maintained and cleaned each day before contractors have completed work.
