TEMPORARY HANDICAPPED PLACARD INFORMATION

The Bernards Township Police Department issues temporary handicapped placards for township residents only.

- Obtain an application, either from your physician or the Police Department.
- Have your physician fill out the right hand portion of the application, return it and we'll type in the rest of the information needed. Please do not write in any information on the left hand side, except your signature!
- A check in the amount of \$4.00 is needed when you return the application. This check should be made payable to "NJ Motor Vehicle Commission". The handicapped placard will be issued at that time. The recipient's drivers' license (if applicable) is needed to complete the form.
- This placard is valid for six months, and can be renewed one time, for an additional six months. There is no charge for the renewal.
- Do NOT laminate the placard!

PERMANENT PLACARD INFORMATION:

- A permanent handicapped placard is issued by the Motor Vehicle Commission. This is for someone who has a permanent condition. Applications are available by calling the Motor Vehicle Commission at (609) 292-6500 – Special Plate Unit. These placards are available free of charge, and are valid for four years. A renewal form is sent to the home prior to the expiration date. License plates are also available from the Special Plate Unit.
