TALL TREES TO BE PLANTED WHERE THERE ARE NO OVERHEAD WIRES

Acer rubrum	- Red Maple
Acer saccharum	- Sugar Maple
Betula nigra *	- River Birch
Celtis occidentalis	- Common Hackberry
Fraxinus pennsylvanica	- Green Ash
Gymnocladus dioicus	- Kentucky Coffeetree
Liriodendron tulipifera	- Tuliptree
Magnolia acuminata	- Cucumber Magnolia/Cucumbertree
Nyssa sylvatica *	- Blackgum
Quercus bicolor *	- Swamp White Oak
Quercus phellos	- Willow Oak
Taxodium distichum *	- Bald Cypress/Swamp Cypress
Ulmus Americana	- American Elm

* Good for damp to wet sites.

SHORT TREES SUITABLE TO BE PLANTED UNDER OVERHEAD WIRES

Acer spicatum	- Mountain Maple
Amelanchier canadensis	- Serviceberry/June Berry
Cercis canadensis	- Eastern Redbud
Cladrastis kentuka	- Kentucky Yellowwood/American Yellowwood
Cornus florida	- Flowering Dogwood
Hamamelis virginiana	- Common Witch Hazel
Magnolia virginiana	- Sweetbay Magnolia

The genus and species names must match. A variety or cultivar of a named species is acceptable.

OTHER VARIETIES MUST BE APPROVED BY THE TOWNSHIP PRIOR TO PLANTING.

MINIMUM SIZE 3" CALIPER OR AS PER APPROVED PROJECT REQUIREMENTS.

PLANTING LOCATIONS SHALL BE AS PER TOWNSHIP STANDARDS (MAXIMUM SPACING OF 50'), PROJECT REQUIREMENTS OR AS DIRECTED BY TOWNSHIP ENGINEER.
