Kennedy-Martin-Stelle Farmstead

The main block of the Dutch framed house was constructed prior to the American Revolution. The farmstead also includes a late 18th century English barn, Dutch framed wagon house, cowshed and ice house. Rev. Samuel Kennedy was a renowned local minister and educator while Col. Ephraim Martin was a Revolutionary War soldier and New Jersey legislator who was instrumental in securing passage of the Bill of Rights by the legislature.
