# Vape / Smoke Shop Regulations and Zoning

Belardo explained that the Federal and State governments are evaluating current vaping regulations due to recent health concerns. Belardo stated that the FDA currently approves the sale and use of vaping products and therefore the municipality does not have the authority to ban such products or use. A local ban could, however, be addressed through zoning prohibiting entities from having vape / smoke products as a principle use.

The Mayor opened public comment on this topic.

Nancy D'Andrea – 3 Vanderveer Ct. commented against vaping and expressed concern especially for youth. No other comment were heard and the Mayor closed public comment.

Township committee members directed Belardo to draft an ordinance to prohibit smoke/vape shops.
