Services performed by the Risk Manager include but are not limited to those described within the MS&H Risk Management Agreement executed by the Township for such services. Additionally, the Risk Manager shall assist in claims related matters for the Township from reporting to resolution thereof. The Risk Manager also provides Insurance and Employee Benefits related consulting services including an overview of coverages and insurance programs generally available to the Township, at the Township's request. Other services rendered by the Risk Manager may include voluntary employee benefits and health care insurance programs reviews.

WHEREAS, since Bernards Township's current insurance coverage commitment ends on December 31, 2017, there is an immediate need to assist the Municipality in understanding the various coverages available from the Suburban Municipal Joint Insurance Fund and the Municipal Excess Liability Joint Insurance Fund and such other Joint Insurance Funds and commercially available insurance as may be appropriate; and

WHEREAS, it is agreed that Risk Manager's compensation for any placement of coverage with any Joint Insurance Fund shall be at 6% of the Fund's agreed upon assessment the Township.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Bernards, that Meeker Sharkey & Hurley; PO Box 227; Liberty Corner, NJ be and is hereby appointed Risk Manager for a three-year term expiring 11/28/2020, with compensation for any placement with a Joint Insurance Fund set at 6% of that Joint Insurance Fund's agreed upon assessment; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Bernards that we do hereby authorize execution of a contract with the Meeker Sharkey & Hurley in accordance with this appointment.
