## REPORTS

### Status Report from IT – Network Disruption of 05/11/20

IT Director Chris Kyriacou reported that malware was detected on the network system at 6:45 PM on 05/11/20. IT staff immediately informed the Administrator and a forensic team through the insurance carrier. It took the back-up storage vendor 7 business days to transfer 8 terabytes of data for shipment. The data was examined, and it was confirmed that there appeared to be no security risk in restoring the back-up data. 95 workstations and 15 servers were restored /rebuilt in a gradual restoring process, and the network system was fortified, with recommendations from the forensic team and the consultant hired prior to the incident to audit the system. There was no evidence of any data loss. The system is backed-up nightly which has proved to be invaluable. The ransomware was "Lock2Bits" but no ransom amount was made or paid. The insurance had a \$10,000 deductible.

<u>Resolution #2020-0222</u> – Permitting Relief of Certain Ordinances to Assist Local Businesses as they Re-Open Following the Lifting of COVID-19 Executive Orders

**WHEREAS**, in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, Governor Murphy issued Executive Order #103, on March 9, 2020, declaring and proclaiming a public health emergency and state of emergency in the State of New Jersey; and

**WHEREAS,** numerous Executive Orders have been issued by the Governor since that time to deal with a myriad of economic and social issues affecting New Jersey residents due to the COVID-19 pandemic; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of New Jersey is implementing a multi-stage plan for reopening businesses and activities based on health factors; and

**WHEREAS,** the Township Committee of the Township of Bernards desires to relax, waive, and modify various portions of the Revised General Ordinances of Bernards Township in order to assist local businesses within Bernards Township in instituting re-opening activities during New Jersey's multi-stage plan, which may include but not be limited to, 21-16, 21-19.5, and 21-63.1; and

**WHEREAS,** Bernards Township's Emergency Declaration, signed on 03/24/2020, states that "the Mayor is authorized to grant temporary deviations or variances from the Township's General and Land Development Ordinances where emergent circumstances for the benefit of the public health, safety and welfare so require" and the Township Committee wishes to affirm its commitment to the health, safety and welfare of its residents; and

**WHEREAS,** activities for which portions of the Ordinances may be relaxed, waived, and modified in Bernards Township may include, but not be limited to, activities such as 1) signage for businesses; 2) curbside pick-up for food or merchandise; 3) outdoor seating for dining; 4) outdoor storage and sale of merchandise; 5) street closings for certain activities, 6) other services that can be performed outdoors.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Bernards that pursuant to paragraph 8 of the March 24, 2020, Township Emergency Declaration, that the Engineering Department be authorized to develop and issue a "Special Use Permit" to local businesses to permit and facilitate various activities of re-opening their business and such permit shall outline the activities and manner for how these activities and uses are to be conducted; and

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that such "Special Use Permit" application shall have no fee or cost for local businesses and shall be submitted to the Zoning Officer for review which may include additional reviews from the Fire Official, the Health Department, the Police Department, the Public Works Department, the Risk Manager, the Administrator, and any other relevant department, to protect the health and safety of citizens participating in said activities. Applications will be reviewed, and "Special Use Permits" issued within 5 days, unless more time is needed due to unusual circumstances or complexity of an application. "Special Use Permits" may be amended, changed or withdrawn as determined by the issuing authority at any time; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED**, that any such activity covered by a "Special Use Permit" that is located within a public right-of-way and/or on township owned properties, the applicant shall provide to Bernards Township a Certificate of Insurance and a Hold Harmless Agreement indemnifying Bernards Township in accordance with 4-4.6 of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Bernards.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED,** that this Resolution shall take effect when such reopening activities are permitted by State statutes, regulations, or Executive Orders of Governor Murphy and accompanying Executive Directives from the New Jersey Department of Health, and may be amended, modified, or changed at any

This Ordinance shall automatically have no further legal force or effect (without further action of the Township Committee) on November 1, 2020, unless this Ordinance is further extended by Resolution of the Township Committee.
