WHEREAS, the Township Committee hereby determines that a 1% increase in the budget for said year, amounting to \$283,391.56 in excess of the increase in final appropriations otherwise permitted by the Local Government Cap Law, is advisable and may be necessary; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee hereby determines that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to the final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years.
