**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Bernards in the County of Somerset, New Jersey that the sum of \$5,166,485.81 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvement Fund, for the following purposes:

А	\$3,374,985.81	Engineering Improvement Projects including but not limited to Roadway Management and Reconstruction, Sidewalk and Drainage Improvements, Township Aerials, and Pedestrian Bridges & Paths.
В	\$415,000.00	Facility Improvements including but not limited to: Repairs and Improvements to the following structures: Engineering Services Building, Health Dept., Police HQ, Various Parks & Recreation Facilities, and Municipal Building.
С	\$440,000.00	DPW Projects and Equipment including but not limited to: Various Roadway Repairs, Bituminous Concrete Facility Repair; Guiderail Repair and Replacement; Repair and Retrofit Drainage; Small Equipment.

Any grant moneys received for the purposes described above hereof shall be applied to direct payment of the cost of the improvements and shall reduce the amount authorized from the capital improvement fund to the extent that such funds are so used.

The period of usefulness is five years or more. The capital budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistencies herewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing all detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services is on file with the Township Clerk and are available for public inspection.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication in accordance with law.
