BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Bernards, County of Somerset and State of New Jersey, that the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Bernards, Chapter 21, "Land Development," Section 21-17, "Signs," shall be amended, revised and supplemented as follows (new text is <u>double underlined</u>; deleted text is <u>stricken</u>):

§ 21-17.2 General Sign Regulations (applicable to all signs in all zones).

- 1. The following design standards shall apply to all signs:
 - 1. Lettering <u>and</u> numbering on all signs shall not be less than four inches high, <u>except lettering and</u> numbering on signs in the B-1 and B-3 Zones shall not be less than three inches high.
 - 2. All signs shall be constructed of permanent quality materials and shall contain professionally drawn lettering/numbering.
 - 3. With the exception of temporary craftsman/contractor signs and temporary signs for charitable uses, freestanding signs with wire supports and any signs constructed of cardboard or corrugated plastic are prohibited.

WHEREAS, Allen Road CR652 is a county road and Somerville Road is a Township road and the intersection is the responsibility of Somerset County; and

WHEREAS, due to accidents and traffic delays Somerset County proposed a round-about to upgrade the intersection to reduce accidents and reduce traffic delays; and

WHEREAS, the County held an on-line public information presentation earlier this year; and

WHEREAS, the proposed round-about can reduce accidents and delays but requires a very long construction period of at least 12 months; and

WHEREAS, the proposed construction will also require long detours at various times during construction; and

WHEREAS, residents of the Hills development served by Allen Road expressed their opposition and concerns for the proposed round-about; and

WHEREAS, a traffic signal can also reduce accidents and delays but with less construction impact, shorter overall construction time and minimal detours if any; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Bernards that the Township of Bernards does not support the replacement of the 4 way stop at Allen Road and Somerville Road with a round-about and does support the installation of a traffic signal.

<u>Resolution #2022-0458</u> - Authorizing a renewal of Shared Services Agreement with the Borough of Peapack and Gladstone, the Borough of Bernardsville, the Township of Bedminster, and the Township of Bernards, for the Establishment and Operation of a Shared Municipal Court.

WHEREAS, the Township of Bedminster ("Bedminster"), the Borough of Peapack and Gladstone ("Peapack-Gladstone"), the Borough of Bernardsville ("Bernardsville") and the Township of Bernards ("Bernards") have reviewed their needs, resources and personnel and have found that they can assist each other at considerable savings to the tax payers of each municipality by establishing and operating a shared municipal court; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1, et seq., any municipality of the State of New Jersey may contract with any other municipality for the shared provision within their several jurisdictions of any service that any party to the agreement is empowered to provide within its own jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 2B:12-1(c), two or more municipalities, by resolution, may agree jointly to provide for courtrooms, chambers, equipment, supplies and employees for their municipal courts and agree to appoint judges and administrators without establishing a joint municipal court; and

WHEREAS, in a Shared Municipal Court, each Court retains its own identity; and

WHEREAS, the Shared Municipal Court shall be operated as four separate courts, pursuant to which Bedminster is the host municipality and provides the services described in this Agreement to Peapack and Gladstone, Bernardsville and Bernards; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Bernards adopted resolution 2020-0209 and 2020-0243 authorizing a shared services agreement with the Borough of Peapack and Gladstone, the Borough of Bernardsville, the Township of Bedminster, and the Township of Bernards, for the Establishment and Operation of a Shared Municipal Court; and

WHEREAS, that agreement expires December 31, 2022; and

WHEREAS, a renewal of the Shared Services Agreement, in the form attached hereto and made a part hereof, was negotiated and agreed to by Bedminster, Peapack-Gladstone, Bernardsville and Bernard which renews a shared municipal court and provides for the sharing of court facilities and court staff including the municipal judge, court administrators, other court employees, prosecutors, public defenders and security personnel for the period January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2025; and

WHEREAS, Bedminster, Peapack-Gladstone, Bernardsville and Bernards have negotiated a Shared Services Agreement, which is attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, the Shared Services Agreement has been reviewed by the Township Attorney, along with representatives of the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Bernards finds it to be in the best interest of the Township and its residents to enter into this Shared Services Agreement with Peapack-Gladstone, Bernardsville, Bedminster, and Bernards for the establishment and operation of a shared municipal court.

COMMENCING ON OR ABOUT January 1, 2023, NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Bernards, in the County of Somerset, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

- 1. There shall be a shared municipal court servicing the Township of Bedminster, Borough of Peapack and Gladstone, Borough of Bernardsville and Township of Bernards subject to compliance with the terms and conditions of the approval of Honorable Yolanda Ciccone, A.J.S.C.
- 2. The Mayor and Township Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute the attached Shared Services Agreement with the Borough of Peapack and Gladstone, the Borough of Bernardsville, the Township of Bernards, and the Township of Bernards, which Agreement sets forth the terms and conditions for the operation of the shared municipal court, including the sharing of court facilities and court staff including the municipal judge, court administrators, other court employees, prosecutors, public defenders and security personnel.
- 3. The Township Clerk/Administrator, Township Attorney and other appropriate Township officials are further authorized to take any and all action required to comply with this Agreement.
- 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption, and the adoption of the appropriate mechanism approving the Shared Services Agreement adopted by the Township.
