a. **REACH (Ridge Education Action & Community Health)**. REACH met twice in January and twice in February. Meetings are still virtual. Instagram is updated at least 3x a week. Out. REACH Newsletter -REACH is coming out with a newsletter to be sent out monthly that will include information on their 4 main topics for 2021-2022 (Drug Use, Mental Health, LGBTQ+, Environment).

### b. Grab and Go Teen Outreach

Kits were handed out in January – DIY Hot Chocolate Bombs. Pick up for February will be February 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> and will be DIY Bath Bombs. Kaitlin Cartoccio met with Rachel Talbert and discussed the crafts for 2022.

## RACE to be Human – February 24<sup>th</sup> 7pm

Virtual documentary screening of "RACE to be Human" a documentary about race and racism and the effects it has on mental health. Documentary is done by IndieFlix which also created "LIKE", "Upstanders" and "Angst. The Alliance discussed and agreed to cosponsor the screening with the other Somerset County Municipal Alliances.

## • Bernards Township School District Pride Survey

The PRIDE Survey was administered in December to Bernards Township  $6^{th}$ ,  $8^{th}$ ,  $10^{th}$ , and  $12^{th}$  grade students. Response rate was very low due to some confusion surrounding the survey and the COVID-19 Omicron surge. The survey will be readministered in the next school year.

- Hope & Healing Support programs Resiliency Workshops
  Family Support Services in Camden offers statewide resiliency
  workshops through the FEMA Hope & Healing Support programs. Can
  offer resiliency workshops to teens and adults. Hoping to partner with
  the schools. Can also provide resources for seniors.
- LGBTQ ATOD Prevention Programs Partners in Prevention/Lindsey Meyer Teen Institute
   Monies have been encumbered to provide LGBTQ ATOD Trainings to REACH students and a community-wide workshop.
