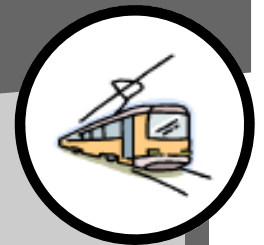

Frequently Asked Questions:

Where can a resident who rides the bus or train park in Bernards Township?

- There are three municipal lots operated by the township: Lyons Train Station, Basking Ridge Train Station, and Stonehouse Road Bus Station.
- NJ Transit also operates a lot at Lyons Train Station (call (800) 523-1026 for info).

Where are municipal commuter lots located?

- The Lyons Train Station lot is behind the Stop and Shop Shopping Center in Lyons and can be accessed by turning onto Thomson Way off Lyons Road.
- The Basking Ridge Train Station lot is on Depot Place off of Ridge Street.
- The Stonehouse Rd Bus lot is located on Stonehouse Rd across from the gas station.

Do I need a permit to park in a municipal commuter lot?

- Between 5 a.m. Monday and 7 p.m. Friday a valid township-issued electronic permit is required.
- Between 7 p.m. Friday and 5 a.m. the following Monday no electronic permit is required.

Does a permit guarantee me a reserved parking space?

- Electronic permits do not guarantee a space; it is a first-come, first-serve basis.

What if the Lyons lot is full on the municipal side?

- Spaces are available on the NJ Transit side. The parking spaces marked 165-211 are designated for overflow resident electronic permit parking. However, you must pay \$1.25 to NJ Transit in addition to having an electronic permit.

How can I get an electronic permit?

- At the Municipal Clerk's Office, 1 Collyer Lane, Basking Ridge, NJ 07920, either in person, Monday through Friday, from 8:30 A.M. to 4:30 P.M., by mail or at bernards.org under online services.

What do I need to obtain an electronic permit?

- Proof of residency and the registration of the vehicle to be parked in the lot is required.

What does an electronic permit cost?

- Electronic permits are \$160 annually, September 1 – August 31 of each year
- Electronic permits are not prorated for partial terms, or refundable.

Must I be a resident to obtain an electronic permit?

- Yes, electronic permits are only available to Bernards Township residents.

What if I get a different vehicle during the license year, must I replace my permit?

- Yes. There is a \$5 replacement fee for this service and you must provide the new registration information to the Clerk's office.

I only occasionally need to park in a commuter lot, so where can I park?

- Options available for the occasional commuter: 1) The NJ Transit lot at Lyons has 100 spaces for \$2.00/day on a first-come-first basis, pay on site. 2) The Basking Ridge Train Lot has free spaces on the track side of the lot on a first-come, first-serve basis, but spaces are very limited.

Can I park overnight in a municipal commuter lot.

- Yes, overnight parking is permitted in township lots

My vehicle is being repaired. Can I park my rental and/or temporary vehicle in any of the Municipal commuter lots?

- No. Vehicles that do not have an electronic permit are not permitted on commuter lots. Alternate parking is available at the NJ Transit lots. Temporary signage on cars not permitted.

NOTE: Section 8-2.4 of the Revised Township Ordinances "requires all vehicles be parked in any such area with the front of the vehicle facing the control sign, which designates the parking space therefore."
