- From May mtg: Reviewed purpose of Draft Soil Protection Standards for preserved farms.
 Reviewed RTF Amendment Memo extending RTF protection eligibility for the housing of full time, year round equine related farm employees in the same building or facility as horses.
- Per notice from SADC: Reviewed requirement to maintain an updated Farmland
 Preservation Plan (FPP) for PIG eligibility. The FPP must be reviewed and readopted every
 10 years to maintain eligibility. Bernards Township FPP is not currently approved.
